

TOO FEW FACTS FOR RENO.

Mrs. Howard M. Campbell, Jr., of New York Falls to Obtain a Divorce.

RENO, Dec. 17.—Mrs. Emma M. Campbell, wife of Howard Campbell, Jr., junior member of the law firm of Howard Campbell & Son of New York, appeared before Judge Green to-day, asking a divorce, but her testimony in support of charges of cruelty and non-support was so inadequate that the court refused to grant the decree without further consideration.

The husband's attorney had instructions not to oppose the suit. Mrs. Campbell said she was married in Brooklyn Oct. 24, 1903, and left her husband on April 12 last. She declared he was neglectful and directed all his attentions to other women. At a card club he held the hands of other women and kissed them while automobile riding. She also asserted that he was extravagant on himself, and refused her money for herself.
