

# AGAIN PRAYS FOR DIVORCE

## Dr. Bruguiere Files a New Complaint Against His Wife

This Time Wife is Accused of  
Treating the Plaintiff  
Cruelly.

Dr. Peder Bruguiere who on last Saturday withdrew his suit for divorce against his wife, Maryon Bruguiere, from the district court in this city, filed a new and more complete complaint against Mrs. Bruguiere late the same afternoon. The new complaint is much longer than the former one and in it the plaintiff alleges as a further ground for divorce that his wife treated him in a cruel manner. His first suit was brought on the ground of desertion.

In the new ground the plaintiff alleges that his wife treated him with extreme cruelty in the following manner, to-wit: "That she has accused him with unfaithfulness and has attacked his character and that while the plaintiff was practicing medicine in the city and county of San Francisco, during the months of January, February, March, April, May and June of 1904, the defendant constantly followed the plaintiff's female patients from the doctor's office in the Star-King building in said city of San Francisco to the residences of such patients and knowingly, falsely and maliciously, and for the purpose of injuring plaintiff's practice, accuse such patients of alienating the plaintiff's affections from her, all of which resulted in the impairment and ruination of the plaintiff's business as a physician and surgeon in the city of San Francisco. That at various times the defendant for the purpose of injuring the plaintiff's character, told his friends that he had threatened her life with a deadly weapon and that he once made an assault on her with a pistol.

The plaintiff says that there is one child, two years of age as the result of their marriage and he asks that this child be given into the custody of the mother, and that the court fix a reasonable sum for its support during the minority of the child. He asks only that he be granted a divorce.
