Dear Sir:

Mrs. Alice [redacted] is advised that her husband, William [redacted], a resident of Nevada, has filed or is about to file an action for divorce against her. It was Mrs. [redacted]'s intention to file an action against Mr. [redacted] here. She has decided however to go to Reno, and to there contest the action filed by Mr. [redacted] and to file a cross-complaint in this action, if the filing of a cross-complaint by her is proper.

She can be considered a resident of Nevada only upon the theory that the domicile of a wife follows that of the husband. If that rule is not effective there, then the question of course arises whether she must be a resident of Nevada in order to file a cross-complaint in an action for divorce. I would appreciate your advising me on these points.

In the event that Mrs. [redacted] does appear in the action and retains you, she will expect you to secure your compensation together with costs of court from Mr. [redacted], either voluntarily or by court order.

Mr. [redacted] has a pink slip which is the ownership certificate to a LaSalle automobile of Mrs. [redacted] here in Los Angeles. Will you please obtain this pink slip endorsed by Mr. [redacted]?

I would appreciate your forwarding to me a certified copy of whatever decree may be rendered in connection with the matter.
