Dear Judge Bartlett:

We are advised that you have been authorized by Mr. [REDACTED] to represent him in the action for divorce which Mrs. [REDACTED] proposes to shortly commence.

She advises us that there was sent to her the sum of \$1,000. for the purpose of defraying legal and living expenses while in Reno.

It now appears that the \$1,000. will not be sufficient. Our fee is \$250.00 and the court costs, including the fee of a resident witness, will approximate but not exceed \$50. This leaves Mrs. [REDACTED] but \$700. to defray transportation and living costs. Her transportation from Los Angeles to Reno alone was \$100. Her rental, not including meals, at the Riverside Hotel per month is \$425. It can be plainly seen that with the usual tips and food



requirements that there will not be enough to meet all of these requirements. Mrs. [REDACTED] has lived fairly comfortably but not extravagantly and has resorted to every reasonable economy, but simply cannot keep her budget within the amount allotted. She brought with her her maid and her son. They are also living at the Riverside Hotel, which is the only suitable place which could be found. Efforts have been made by several realtors to locate her in less expensive living quarters, but the same were not available.

Mrs. [REDACTED] feels that to cover all of these expenses there should be allotted to her an additional \$500. and we are writing you to ask that you contact your client, Mr. Randolph C. [REDACTED], to the end that he make a more generous allowance than he has done.

I am sending this letter to you in duplicate so that you may transmit one to your client. In case you are not advised, we understand that Mr. [REDACTED]'s address is 229 Ward Parkway, Kansas City, Missouri.
