RENO DIVORCES NEAR END.

Nevada's Six Months' Residence Law Valueless After To-day.

RENO, June 29.—After 12 o'clock tomorrow night the Reno divorce bureau will go out of business. After that hour it will not be possible for the divorce seeker to take advantage of the six months' residence clause which has been in effect in Nevada for years.

The amended divorce law requiring a year's residence before application for divorce may be made goes into effect on Jan. 1, 1914. It will be impossible for one arriving in Nevada after June 29 to comply with the six months' requirement of the present law.

Reno divorce lawyers have thrown up their hands. For years Reno has been held up to ridicule because of its divorce colony, and aside from the few decrees that will be granted to those already taking advantage of the six months' law, the divorce mills will have little grist in the future.
